



## 2010 Terms of Enrollment

(Enrollment applications are conditional upon acceptance and the agreement to the following terms):

- **Tuition:** includes supervision, meals, laundry, in-camp medical attention and daily snacks.
- **Medical:** prescription medicines, special doctor fees or hospital care are not included and a credit card is required (below) for these purposes. All campers are required to have health insurance.
- **Trips:** one standard overnight trip is included for 4 and 5-week campers. An additional fee will be charged for premium trips and trips for short-term campers (3 weeks and less).
- **Deposit:** unless otherwise stated, an enrollment deposit of \$750 should accompany each enrollment application.
- **Payments:** \$250 payments will be due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of December, January, February and April. The credit card number you give below will be used to make these recurring charges. The final balance will be due June 1<sup>st</sup>. Credit cards will be accepted for the final payment for an additional \$50.00 convenience fee. Late payments are subject to interest payments of 10%. T-shirts and premium trips will be billed to the credit card with the April payment
- **Cancellation and refunds:** in the event of cancellation, all payments will be refunded should the registration be cancelled prior to November 14<sup>th</sup>. No refunds after November 15<sup>th</sup>.
- **Optional expenses:** transportation to and from the airport and any additional store, special crafts or optional items purchased or chosen by the camper will be added to your final statement at the end of the summer.
- **Extending camp and late or early arrival:** Campers may extend their stay, space permitting, at the weekly rate. There will be no refund or prorating of fees for campers arriving late or leaving early. Registering for the most number of weeks up-front ensures the best price.
- **Tuition Insurance:** available through Camp Protector, **we strongly recommend utilizing this insurance, as we provide no refunds after November 15<sup>th</sup>**. Insurance is very affordable (about \$125 for 5 weeks). Cancellation due to specific causes and cancellation for any cause are available. - **Wholesome Environment:** Camp is a wholesome environment for children and campers should dress and act accordingly. The camp uniform is a camp logo t-shirt plus blue, white or khaki shorts (or pants on cold or rainy days). Campers are required to have 5 camp logo t-shirts, which they need to wear daily except for optional shirt Fridays and camp designated theme days (e.g. Pirate Day Clothing or swimwear that is too revealing or inappropriate (i.e. spaghetti straps, string bikinis, pants or shorts too low etc.), in the sole discretion of the camp director, will not be permitted.
- **Camper Behavior:** Directors reserve the right to dismiss, **without tuition refund, any camper**, whose behavior, in the camp director's sole discretion, is inappropriate, harmful to the camper or the camp community.
- **Making Camp Affordable:** Scholarships and financial aid are available on a first come first served basis. Every effort will be made to make camp affordable to those who want to attend.
- **Discounts:** Unless otherwise stated in writing, Early bird discount, sibling and/or any other discount(s) may not be combined.
- **Counselor in Training (CIT) tuition:** Half price and is considered a form of discount. Mandatory CIT trip is \$150 additional.
- **Permissions:** Parent(s) or legal guardian grants camper permission to participate in all camp activities, including camp optional trips and programs chosen by camper. The parent understands that some camp supervised programs and/or optional trips may take place outside of camp.
- **Promotional Permissions:** The parent(s) or legal guardian authorizes the camp to use any of the camper and family photographs, names, quotes, and video for promotional materials (such as videos, brochures, flyers, displays, etc.).
- **Property Damage:** Parent(s) or legal guardian will be held responsible for the payment of repairs or replacement of the camps' and/or other individuals' property or equipment damaged by the camper due to negligence or misbehavior (e.g. graffiti on new cabin interior).
- **Food and Care Packages:** Campers are all well fed and food is available at all times at camp. **Food in cabins and gum at camp are not allowed. Please do not send food or gum.... it will be confiscated!** All care packages will be subject to inspection. This is a health issue and thank you for cooperating
- **Legal Costs:** Any individual, group, or entity bringing legal action against "Camp" (Camp Firebird LLC, its officers, owners, employees, agents, associates or vendors), which results in a decision in favor of "Camp," will be responsible for all related legal, court, and all expenses incurred by "Camp."
